

NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO CALCULATE ISEE PARIFICATO

For foreign students

STUDENT	<input type="checkbox"/> Identity card (if EU countries) or passport <input type="checkbox"/> Codice fiscale (fiscal code) applied either at the Italian Diplomatic Representation in student's country or in Italy at the Revenue Agency (<i>Agenzia delle Entrate</i>). The C.F. is mandatory for the final registration.
SCHOLARSHIP	<input type="checkbox"/> Amount received in 2022 (CU 2023 year 2022)
<p>Students must acquire all the documentation stating their family income and properties by the appropriate offices in their country of residence.</p> <p>All the documents must be translated into Italian by a recognized translator and legalized if non-EU countries by the competent local authority in their country. As an alternative, they can have them translated by their country's Embassy or Consulate in Italy and legalized by the Italian <i>Prefettura</i>.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CAF will only accept ORIGINAL documents issued in 2023</p>	
HOUSEHOLD	<p>WARNING: household means all the people living in the same house with the student (e.g.: parents + siblings + other people living in the same house)</p> <p><u>In case of separated or divorced parents, the applicant belongs to the household of the parent receiving child maintenance for the student.</u></p> <p><u>In the case of parents who are not legally separated or divorced, the household of the applicant will be assessed together with the combined households of both parents.</u></p> <input type="checkbox"/> Certification regarding the family status at the time of ISEE PARIFICATO's signing Below check the option regarding the student's parents condition: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="radio"/> Separated/Divorced <input type="radio"/> Not married and not living together <input type="radio"/> Dead parents <input type="radio"/> Recognized by just one of the parents
HOUSE RENTAL	<input type="checkbox"/> If the family rents a house, the student should provide a copy of the current rental agreement indicating how much is paid monthly
INCOMES	<input type="checkbox"/> income tax return for the year 2022 to enrolment of each family member who has an income (converted into Euro if possible) - documents issued by employers will not be accepted . The official income tax return must be issued by the official government revenue agency of the student's country of residence)
PROPERTIES	<input type="checkbox"/> purchase price or market value for properties owned by the family (building and land) at 31st December 2022. In case of a mortgage on the house (or other property), the student should provide a copy of the mortgage statement indicating the remaining amount at 31 st December 2022 to be paid to the financial institution that provided the loan.
FAMILYESTATE	<input type="checkbox"/> for bank accounts and deposits: balance at 31st December 2022 and the average balance of 2022 (or the bank statement with all year's transactions to permit us to calculate average balance) <input type="checkbox"/> personal estate of the family owned at 31 st December 2022 (assets, dividends, etc)

In case of absence of property/ income / assets for some family member you need a declaration confirming this condition.

The IUP certification will be **exclusively referred to the student's economic situation**, without considering the income and the properties of the family, **only if:**

- he/she has a different residence from the one of the family since at least two years
- he/she does not live in a house belonging to a member of the family
- he/she has a personal income since at least two years. The student's annual income must not be lower than € 9.000
